New additions in traditional villages for Peak Retreats 2021/22 winter programme

Situated in the Portes du Soleil ski area, Les 3 Sophies is in a perfect location for the Prodains cable car that takes you up to Avoriaz.

Vaujany: Opening in December 2021, Les Edelweiss offers spacious south facing, chalet-style apartments. This stylish new residence boasts a hot tub, sauna and steam room.
