Important note: Lesson times are subject to change right until the last minute. For peak periods (Christmas/New Year, February half-term and Easter), we strongly recommend that you book as early as possible and in any case at least 6 weeks prior to the required dates. Morning lessons tend to get booked up first and therefore we may only be able to offer afternoon classes within 6 weeks of departure. Outside French school holidays the ski school reserves the right to cancel group lessons should numbers be insufficient. If numbers are low, children may join adult ski school groups. In some resorts English speaking instructors may not always be available, particularly at peak times. Cancellation or modification of your lessons between 16 and 0 days before departure will incur a cancellation charge of 100%.

Your hands-free lift pass cards will be sent to you in your voucher pack, so you won't have to queue at the lift pass office with a voucher on arrival.
