NEW SELF-CATERED CHALETS

We know that lots of you like to travel with family and friends so finding a large enough property is key. This season we've added more individual self-catered chalets to our programme. These special properties give you enough space for a larger party, yet you benefit from the flexibility of self-catering. ARPETTE RETREAT, PLAGNE 1800

This 160m² chalet sleeps up to 12 in five cosy bedrooms and is at the foot of the slopes. It's got a log burning stove, heated ski lockers and its own sauna.





CHALET BICHOU, LES 2 ALPES This large chalet sleeps up to 15 and has four en-suite bedrooms. It's at the foot of the slopes and has a beautiful south-facing terrace with outdoor hot tub.

NEW IN VALMOREL



This friendly resort in the Tarentaise valley offers 160km of slopes. This season it will boast a new residence, the Akoya, at the foot of the slopes and in the heart of the village. Expect stylish apartments, and great facilities including a wellness area with pool, hot tub, sauna and steam room.

NEW IN MEGEVE

Chic Megève, in the Evasion Mont Blanc ski pass area, will gain a new luxury residence this winter. The Eclat des Vériaz looks stunning. It will have an indoor/outdoor heated pool, wellness area and tapas bar. It's a 10 minute walk from the village centre and lifts, and a shuttle service is planned.









AEROLIVE -STRICTLY FOR ADRENALINE SEEKERS

For a completely unique experience, head to La Plagne

this winter. Aerolive looks like an ordinary gondola cabin, except it has no sides! Skiers will be harnessed into the cabin and feel the sensation of being at one with the elements as they glide on the 20 minute gondola ride from 2739m at the Roche de Mio up to to 3080m. Two Aerolive cabins that will operate on the Glaciers gondola this winter. Not one for the faint-hearted but an extraordinary world-first!

ONES TO WATCH...

We spotted some beautiful new chalet apartments when we were last in Méribel and we're delighted to introduce these for this season. With stylish interiors and huge windows that flood the living area with light, the **Chalets de Mottaret** are a great addition. They are just 80m from the Chalets gondola. Also new this season; **Le Grand Hotel du Soleil d'Or in Megève**, a veritable institution, this 5-star hotel has a rooftop bar (the only one in the resort) and is famed for its chocolate-lovers paradise, Le Chocolaterie, this year it's added a new restaurant dedicated to cheese. And finally,



we have a new residence in Les 2 Alpes. Le Provençal apartments are just 100m from the slopes. Discover even more new properties at peakretreats.co.uk/new

LES ARCS BOASTS NEW GREENER GONDOLA

The Transarc gondola will be even faster next season taking skiers from Arc 1800 up to the Col de la Chal at 2600m in just 13 minutes (compared to 20 minutes today). The upgrade project includes solar panels, which will be integrated into the gondola stations. Great news for those who love this lively resort. We've added a new hotel in Arc 1800 for next season too, the 4-star Altezza.



PICTURE PERFECT POOL & PICNICS!

St Martin de Belleville will have a superb new wellness centre in the village this winter, with a beautiful indoor pool. The resort is also adding a new observation deck and picnic spot at 2500m which will have stunning views and fun slides for children.

CHALET BLANC, ST MARTIN DE BELLEVILLE

This beautifully decorated, spacious chalet for eight is just 180m from the slopes and ski lifts in the pretty 3 Valleys resort of St Martin de Belleville. The living area is decorated in a modern mountain style, but its four bedrooms have a burst of colour that really suits this special chalet. As well as a hot tub on the terrace, it has its own private sauna. There's also a wood burning stove in the living space, perfect for cosy evenings. (See page 9 for more on St Martin).

CHALET AZURITE CHAMONIX

This large six-bedroom chalet sleeps up to 16 and is just 300m from the slopes. The chalet's décor is sleek and contemporary yet the extensive use of wood means it is perfectly in keeping with its Alpine setting. The living area has deep sofas to sink into and the open-plan kitchen/diner offers breathtaking views towards the Mont Blanc massif, plus there is a large south-facing wraparound balcony. Our highlight, however, is the outdoor Nordic bath with mountain views.



CHALET COCOON, PLAGNE 1800

Close to the chairlift in Plagne 1800, Cocoon is part of a group of four properties. This is the largest of the four and sleeps up to 16 adults. We loved the underfloor heating in the bedrooms, the living area with its fireplace and the huge dining area. There's even a bar, where you can arrange for a barrel of beer to be put on tap! The ski room has a sauna and from one of the bedrooms you can access the terrace with a 5-person hot tub that has views of Mont Blanc.
